Wind and Fire STREAMERS



Something to do

For this craft you will need:

- a toilet roll
- blue, white, red and yellow crepe or tissue paper, or just ordinary paper
- a lolly stick (or straw)
- glue or elastic bands

This week we are going to make Pentecost windsocks and/or streamers.

Cut the coloured paper into strips.

For the windsock, glue them onto one end of the toilet roll. For the streamer, you can glue them on or attach them to the lolly stick with an elastic band.

If you blow through the toilet roll, the tongues of fire will move around!

Family Activities

The kids in the video that we watched used some great facial expressions to help tell the story. Re-tell the story of Pentecost in your family using actions, facial expressions, noises and sounds for the wind and flames, and don't forget to use your streamers and windsock too!

Make a card and a gift for someone that you know who doesn't come to church. Send it to them with a note that says God loves them and that you are praying for them.
