When the church started, it started in people's homes. People learnt about God and how to follow Jesus in their front room! We can do the same today!


We hope that in this season you enjoy engaging with God as a family in your home.

Something to talk about

In the story Noah gets 2 of every animal – that's a lot! What is your favourite animal and why?

We heard this week that God spoke to Noah to tell him to build the ark. Has God ever spoken to you? Why not ask your grownups if God has ever spoken to them and ask what happened!

After the flood waters dry up God promises never to send a flood like that again, and sends a rainbow to help us remember that promise. Can you remember any other promises God has made to us?

Something to do

For this craft you will need:

A copy of the printable cloud (on the next page), some strips of coloured paper, colouring pens or pencils, some glue and some string or pipe cleaner.

Colour in the text on the cloud, then stick the strips of paper on to make a rainbow. You can attach a bit of string or pipe cleaner to hang it up if you like.
